SHAIKH SHAFAYAT'S MESSAGE

YURSA (EASE) vs. USRA (DIFFICULTY)

Brothers and sisters, everyone wants a life free of hardship and difficulties. But this is never the reality, is it? Life itself is a concept of duality: yursa (ease) and ursa (difficulty). Both are part and parcel of human life! It is

Sis. R. Mohammed important as Muslims who believe in the Qur'aan and follow the Sunnah of Prophet Mohammed (SAW) to live a life with belief and faith in Allaah (SWT). Allaah (SWT) is the one who makes yursa (ease) for us and has promised to make every ursa (difficulty) followed by ease, prosperity and success. And Allaah (SWT) tells us in the Qur'aan, Chapter 94, Surah Al-Inshirah – "Fa inna ma'al usri yusra Inna ma'al 'usri yusra": "that certainly with every difficulty comes ease". Allaah (SWT) is telling us in Chapter 94, if we can endure the hardships and stand firm against the miseries we are faced with, then with patience and Imaan, he will always provide a solution, a way out, a relief, a way that leads to ease and happiness. There is always going to be some challenging situation, something that tries to discourage us and break our faith in Allaah (SWT). But we must remain firm in our faith and believe that Allaah will take care of us! We can take a look at two examples in history. 1. First, is that of Prophet Mohammed (SAW). The prophet always had a positive demeanor and greeted everyone with "Alhamdulillah 'alaa kuli haal" translated as "all praise and thanks are only for Allaah (SWT) in all circumstances". He never depicted himself as depressed, worried or angry. Yet despite his positive demeanor, his Imaan was tested when his two young sons died and people began ridiculing him, stating his God was displeased with him and he had no heir to continue legacy. But Allaah (SWT) revealed to him in Chapter 108, Surah Al Kauther, verses 1-2: "Innaa a'taina kal kauthar, Fa salli li rabbika wanhar", translated as "surely Mohammed (SAW), we have given you an abundance of goodness, therefore turn to your lord with prayer and sacrifice." Mohammed (SAW) was told not to worry about the two sons he had lost (ursa). But rather look at the abundance or "kauthar" Allaah(SWT) had given him (yursa), that is, the millions of followers in the world to continue the legacy and fellowship of Islam.

2. The second example is that of Adam and Hawwa (Eve). When Allaah (SWT) created Adam, he gave him paradise. Then Allaah (SWT) created a wife for him, Hawwa, because he was lonely and needed tranquility and a companion in his life. Allaah (SWT) gave them permission to everything in paradise, the only exception being the 'tree'. They were forbidden to eat from the tree. Satan saw an opportunity to exploit Adam and Hawwa's weaknesses. And what did Satan do? And what did Satan do? He began creating doubts in Adam and Hawwa minds' and they begin asking themselves: 'why is Allaah (SWT) forbidding us from going to that tree?



THE GRAND MOSQUE OF PARIS A Story of How Muslims Rescued Jews During the Holocaust and Free Men

I recently came across a children's book "The Linda M. Kaplan Grand Mosque of Paris" written by Karen Gray

Ruelle and Deborah Durlan DeSaiz and the movie "Free Men" which is a fictional story inspired by the events described in the book. Free Men was co-written and directed by Ismael Ferroukhi. Jewish Book World Magazine rated the Grand Mosque of Paris, 5 out of 5 stars. It is suggested for children from age 8-11 but is likely to be of interest to young adults as well as not so young adults. The story told in the book will be of interest to all ages. The book is remarkable not just for the story but also for the beautiful double page oil paintings which convey the desperation and the danger of the Nazi occupation of Paris. Some of the painting also convey hope as do the words of the book which includes a glossary and an extensive bibliography. It includes the message - "Save one life, and it is as if you've saved all of humanity" which is both an Islamic Hadith (saying of the Prophet Muhammad) and a Jewish Proverb. The Grand Mosque of Paris tells the story of how Muslims at the Paris Mosque rescued Jews during the Nazi occupation. The Mosque was built in 1926 when Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia were under French rule and many Muslims had come to Paris from those countries. The land for the Mosque was a gift from the French government to thank the half- million Muslims who fought for France during WW 1. It included a community center, library, steam baths, gardens, clinic, restaurant and apartments for those who worked there. Some of the people who worked and lived there had children which allowed them to hide North African Jewish children among their own. Below the subbasement of the mosque were tunnels, damp rooms (in which the adults were harbored) and hundreds of miles of dark passageways in which one could easily be lost or, if you knew the way, make your way to an escape on the Seine river. The book explains that the people of North Africa, Jews and Muslim lived as neighbors, shared similar cultures, referred to each other as brothers and looked very much alike. This is why Salim, a gay Jewish man from Algeria was able to safely live in the Mosque and pretend to be Muslim. Others who could not pass as North African Muslims were hidden for a few days at the Mosque until they could escape via a barge from the Mosque to a central wine market on the banks of the Seine River. Two of the people who escaped via the barge were Albert Assouline, a Jew and Yassa Rahal, a Muslim who were friends from North Africa. After they escaped from a prisoner of war camp in Germany they managed to get to Paris, sheltered at the Mosque for a few days until they could be smuggled onto the barge and hidden among the wine barrels for their escape from Paris.

A Death-Dealing Journey For A Better Life

Fear... Have you ever wondered how it feels like to live life in a constant state of fear? First you probably have to experience extreme difficulty in order to understand the magni-Dr. Harun Yahya tude of the danger that the Rohingyas are in.

However since that will likely not be possible, you can never truly understand or feel how a Rohingya residing in the Rakhine State lives with threat for his or her life. They live through this persistent fear and continue their lives in very harsh conditions in several registered or mostly unregistered camps. The world first heard their names when violent clashes between the Buddhists and Muslims arose in 2012 in Rakhine State and hundreds have been killed since then. According to the Humans Rights Watch, thousands of houses were burnt in Rohingya villages in Arakan. Even when these poor people did not appear in the news headlines, they were still exposed to unabated maltreatment and oppression. Therefore, HRW categorized them as the world's most persecuted people. The clashes in Rakhine re-escalated when nine police officers were killed on October 9 by armed assaulters whose identities are still unknown and in response to this attack Myanmar soldiers spilled onto border of Myanmar and Bangladesh looting villages, shooting men, and raping women. This sudden increase in violence urged a great many Rohingyas to flee the country. These last forty days are considered to be the bloodiest since the 2012 clashes; more than 100 people have been killed and nearly 500 houses were burnt in these recent attacks. In addition to all these, the region suffers nearly a complete lockdown on humanitarian aid and media access as UN official Yanghee Lee complained, "It is not acceptable that for six weeks there has been a complete lockdown, with no [humanitarian] access to the affected area." Due to the lack of humanitarian aid, 3,000 children suffering with severe acute malnutrition in the area are at the risk of dying and 150,000 people are suspended from receiving food and medications. Amid all these sufferings, Myanmar's de facto leader San Suu Kyi is being seriously criticized due to her silence and denying all the accusations against these ongoing crimes. When she came to power about a year ago, people hoped she would make some improvements and bring change in terms of human rights issues since she was considered a democracy icon and was herself a Nobel Peace Prize laureate. Even, the US administration eased the sanctions against Myanmar hoping that, among other achievements, the new government will focus on bringing "respect for human rights to its people." However, things exacerbated since she came to power and she didn't take any steps to stop this persecution. Against all odds, these persecuted people flee their homelands with the hope of a better life.






A few months ago, I gave a little insight into the life of that distinguished soldier - first youth to accept Islam – Hazrat Ali. Coming from the Banu Hashim, Quraish's most respectable family, Hazrat Ali (R.A.) lived up to expectations by setting high standards of the virtues of humanity

- -'One who thinks himself the best is the worst.'
- -'Better be alone than with bad company.'
- -'Every breath of man is a step nearer to death.'

Hazrat Ali was truly a colossus on the world's stage for he shaped the minds of people in his time and still continues to impact on Muslims and others today. 



THE GRAND MOSQUE OF PARIS

A Story of How Muslims Rescued Jews During the Holocaust & Free Men

Ahmed Somia, a Muslim doctor from Tunisia worked to protect Jewish children at risk of arrest by fabricating illnesses and sending them to clinics away from Paris. They provided some with false identity papers showing them to be Muslim or Christian. At the Muslim hospital where he worked, he and the other doctors hid Allied pilots and parachutists by day and treated them at night. Some of the patients treated had come to France as spies and some were shot down by Nazis. After they were treated they were transported to shelter at the Mosque. The book quotes a letter that was found in the papers of a Tunisian owned Paris café. In July of 1942 almost thirteen thousand Jews were arrested in Paris. The letter is believed to have been written during the summer of 1942. It was translated from Kabyle, a language from the Atlas Mountains of Algeria: "Yesterday at dawn, the Jews of Paris were arrested. The elderly, the women and the children. In exile like ourselves, workers like ourselves. They are our brothers. Their children are like our own children. Anyone who encounters one of his children must give that child shelter and protection for as long as misfortune- or sorrow- lasts. Oh man of my country, your heart is generous." The book speculates whether the letter was read out in the café or circulated among the Kabyle workers of Paris or the boarding houses where the men lived but states that this letter seems to be a call to action and proof of the strong bond between the North African Muslims and Jews. The movie, Free Men, which was inspired by the story in The Grand Mosque of Paris, premiered at the 2011 Cannes Film Festival. The film weaves fictional characters into the story alongside real characters. Algerian-born Jewish historian Benjamin Stora has acted as an adviser on Free Men. Younes, a fictional character, is a young Muslim man from Algeria who sell cigarettes, eggs and whatever else he can sell on the black market. He is caught by the French Immigration police who recruit him to spy on the Mosque which is suspected of aiding Jews. In his efforts to spy for the police he meets the rector of the Mosque, Si Kaddour Benghabrit and Salim Halali who were both real people. Si Kaddour Benghabrit was considered to be the most influential Muslim in France and Salim was a young Berber Jew from Algeria, a celebrated singer, pretending to be Muslim. After being mentored by the rector, Younes begins to assist the rector and Salim in assisting in the escape of the Jews in Paris, some of whom were sheltered in the Mosque. Younes becomes interested in Leila, a beautiful Jewish woman living in the Mosque (as a Muslim) and working to help other Jews, including her brother, escape. Salim had been provided a Certificate of Conversion to show that his grandfather had converted to Islam. When the Nazis began suspecting that the Mosque was providing false Muslim birth certificates and fake conversion certificates to Jews, the rector arranged to have an unmarked tombstone in the Muslim cemetery engraved with Salim's family name which saved his life when he was picked up by the Nazis.

Supplicating at the most Opportune **Times & Locations**

Question: How and when is the best time to make Dua?

Answer: These are, for instance, the day of 'Arafah, month of Ramadan, Friday, the last part of the night, at dawn, during prostration, at the time of rainfall, between the adhan and igamah, at the time of encounter of armies, at times of panic, and when one's heart is soft and tender. Abu Umamah reported, "The Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W), was asked, 'What supplication finds the greatest acceptance?' He answered: 'A prayer offered in the middle of the latter part of the night and after the prescribed Prayers'.' (Reported by Tirmidhi with a sound chain of authorities) Abu Hurairah reported, the Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) said, "The servant is nearest to his Lord when he is prostrating to Him, so make supplication in this state." (Muslim) There are very many hadith found in various books on this subject.Starting the Supplication with Allah's Praise and Blessings on His Prophet. Fudalah b. 'Ubaid reported that the Prophet (S.A.W), heard a man supplicating during prayer. He did not glorify Allah, nor did he invoke blessings on the Prophet. The Prophet, peace be upon him, said, "He has been hasty." Then he called the man and said either to him, or to someone else, "When any one of you prays, he should begin by glorifying and praising his Lord and then he should invoke blessings on the Prophet, peace be upon him, and after that he should supplicate Allah for anything he wishes."







